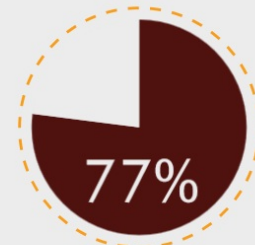
POST GRADUATION OUTCOMES – RECENT GRADUATE SURVEY RESULTS

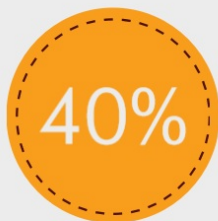

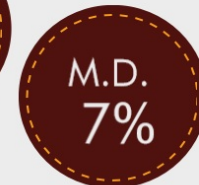

GRADUATE/PROFESSIONAL SCHOOL



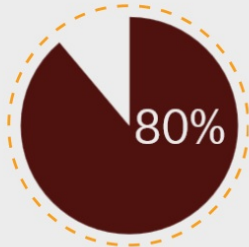
Graduates who reported pursuing graduate/professional education within one year of graduation

DEGREES PURSUED

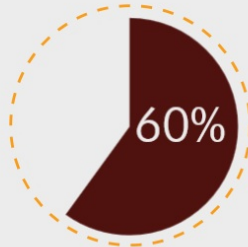

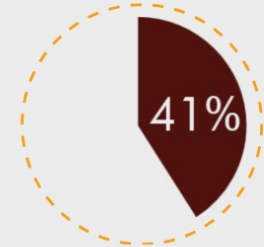
CAREER PREPARATION AT ADELPHI

Seniors who reported working with a faculty member on activities other than coursework



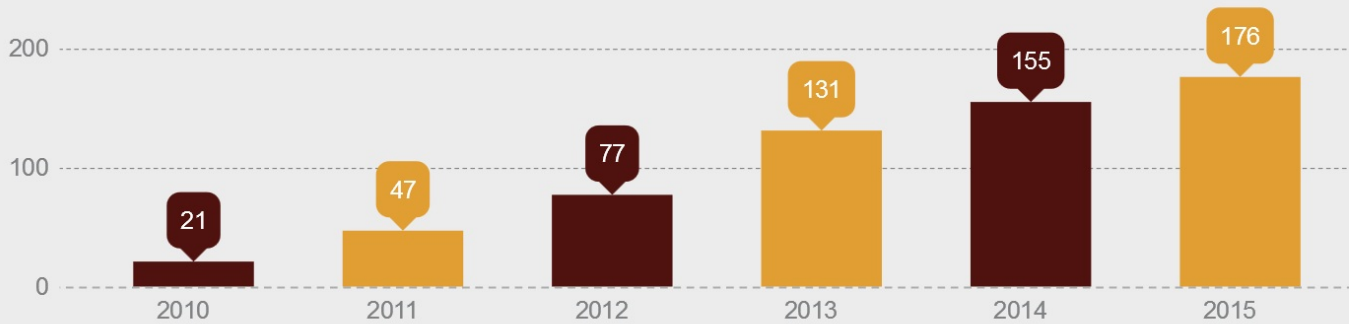
Seniors who indicated that they held a formal leadership role in a student organization or club
